2. **Show/Audition Process**

- No one cut from process; understand excitement/disappointments; not everyone can be Simba, Mufasa, Nala or the Assistant Stage Manager
- Just because you didn't get cast in role you wanted does not mean you didn't do a good job in auditions or interviews
