

# Drama Club Expectations

- Always check your rehearsal schedule
- Be on time to every meeting, rehearsal, tech call and performance.
- If you are going to be late to or absent from one of above, notify the director.
- Pay attention, work hard, follow directions, and refrain from unnecessary talking during rehearsals.
- Always bring your script, a pencil and a folder to rehearsals.
- Take down any notes you are given and review them at home.
- Do your homework and rehearse at home when you can.
- Respect your fellow cast and crew members; treat them with courtesy.
- Don't tell others how to do their job.
- Don't talk behind others' backs.
- Do not complain. If you have any major concerns, talk to the director, stage managers or their assistants.
- Remember: Family First, Schoolwork Second, Drama Club Third.
- The Stage is a place for creativity but not a playground. No child/student should be on stage at any times unless they are rehearsing.
- When not on stage rehearsing, participants need to be seated and quiet in the house. This allows for all stage directions to be heard and eliminate confusion.
- Absolutely NO climbing on the stadium seating (bleachers) or on folded tables.
- Sets, costumes and other equipment on stage are the property of the OMS drama club and are not to be touched, used or damaged.
- Absolutely NO food or beverages other than water allowed on stage
- Jumping on or off the stage is dangerous. When entering or exiting the stage area, use the stairs provided on both sides of the stage.
- The main curtain (maroon) and the stage curtains (black) are custom made, specially treated, and very expensive. Care and consideration are to be used when using these materials
